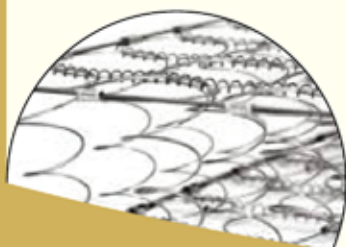

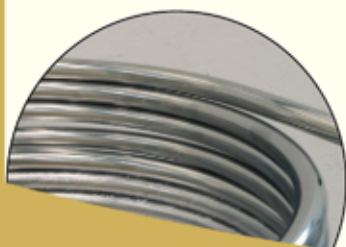

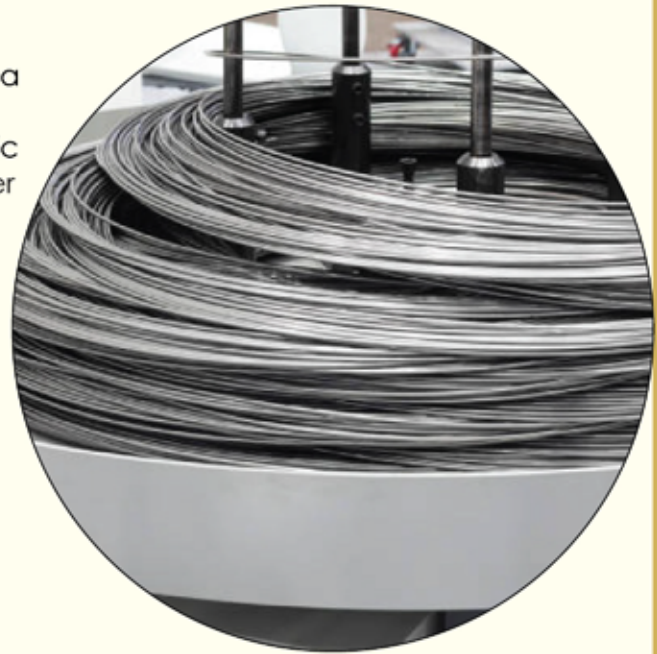

This process is done to achieve the increase of Wire Ductility & to decrease the hardness of wire by increasing its Elongation & to achieve uniform grain structure.

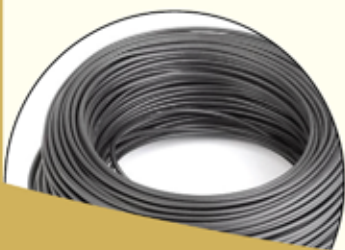

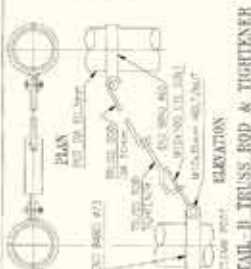


DETAIL-D BRACE CUP

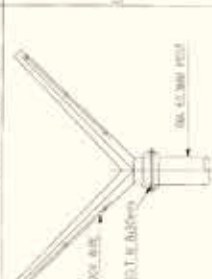
